## SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

## Item 6: Teacher Standards and Practices Commission Licensing and Investigations Backlog

The Education Subcommittee recommends that the Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means recommend including an increase of \$914,270 in Other Funds expenditure limitation for the Teacher Standards and Practices Commission, and authorizing the establishment of eight limited duration positions (5.00 FTE) in a budget reconciliation bill during the 2024 legislative session to address a backlog of investigations and applications for licensure.

Post-pandemic, the Commission has seen a sharp increase in the number of complaints of educator misconduct it receives. Likewise, applications for licensure have risen past prepandemic levels. Both of these workload increases have led to unforeseen processing backlogs, which further slow operations. Higher than expected fee revenues from last biennium provide one-time resources in the current biennium for hiring two limitedduration public service representatives and six investigations positions to work through and eliminate these backlogs.

The Education Subcommittee recommends approval.
