Item 71: Oregon Board of Dentistry DAS Shared Financial Services Transition

To: Ways and Means Full Committee

The Education Subcommittee recommends that the Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means acknowledge receipt of a report on the Oregon Board of Dentistry's review of transitioning budget and accounting services from the Oregon Medical Board to the Department of Administrative Services, with the understanding that the Board will transition budget and accounting services to the Department of Administrative Services, effective July 1, 2024.

A budget note directed the Board of Dentistry to review the most cost effective and efficient approach for transitioning its budget and accounting services from the Oregon Medical Board to the Department of Administrative Services, Shared Financial Services. Transitioning these services will provide the Board with enhanced support for its budget and accounting functions.

The Department of Administrative Services will maintain the current rate charged by the Oregon Medical Board for this service through the 2023-25 biennium. Beginning in the 2025-27 biennium, the Board of Dentistry's budget will be developed according to the rate methodology used for DAS Shared Financial Services support. The Board anticipates implementing a fee increase in 2025-27 to support this change, among other increasing costs.
