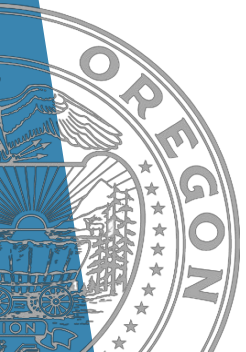

## *Retrospective:*


 2023 Oregon Cybersecurity Plan approved by CISA/FEMA.

 Year 1 funding allocated, and full match waiver granted.

 Statewide Cybersecurity Services Catalog prioritized services in tiers.

 Grant application processing framework completed.

 Grant application registration website stood up.

 Registration and application submission deadlines set.

Registration deadline set to November 15, 2023.

Proposal submission deadline set to January 10, 2024.

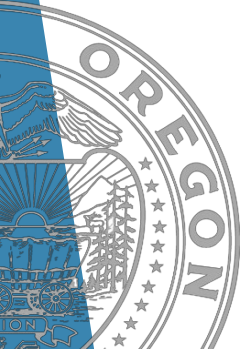

# IIJA SLCGP – FFY22 (Year 1) Activities Update

## *Current:*



98 proposals were submitted from 47 entities for the planning committee to review and recommend.



60 proposals, totaling \$2.8 million, were reviewed and recommended for funding.



Planning committee delegated five subcommittees to expedite the review process.



15 proposals were returned to submitting entities for more work; CSS staff assisted entities to fill gaps.



14 of the 15 returned proposals were recommended after remedial work was completed.



38 proposals were not recommended for funding.

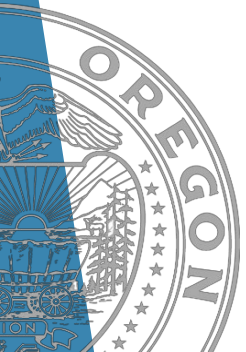

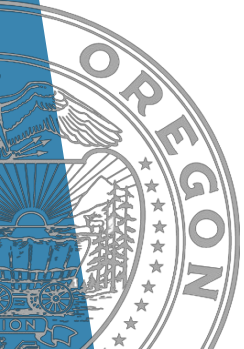
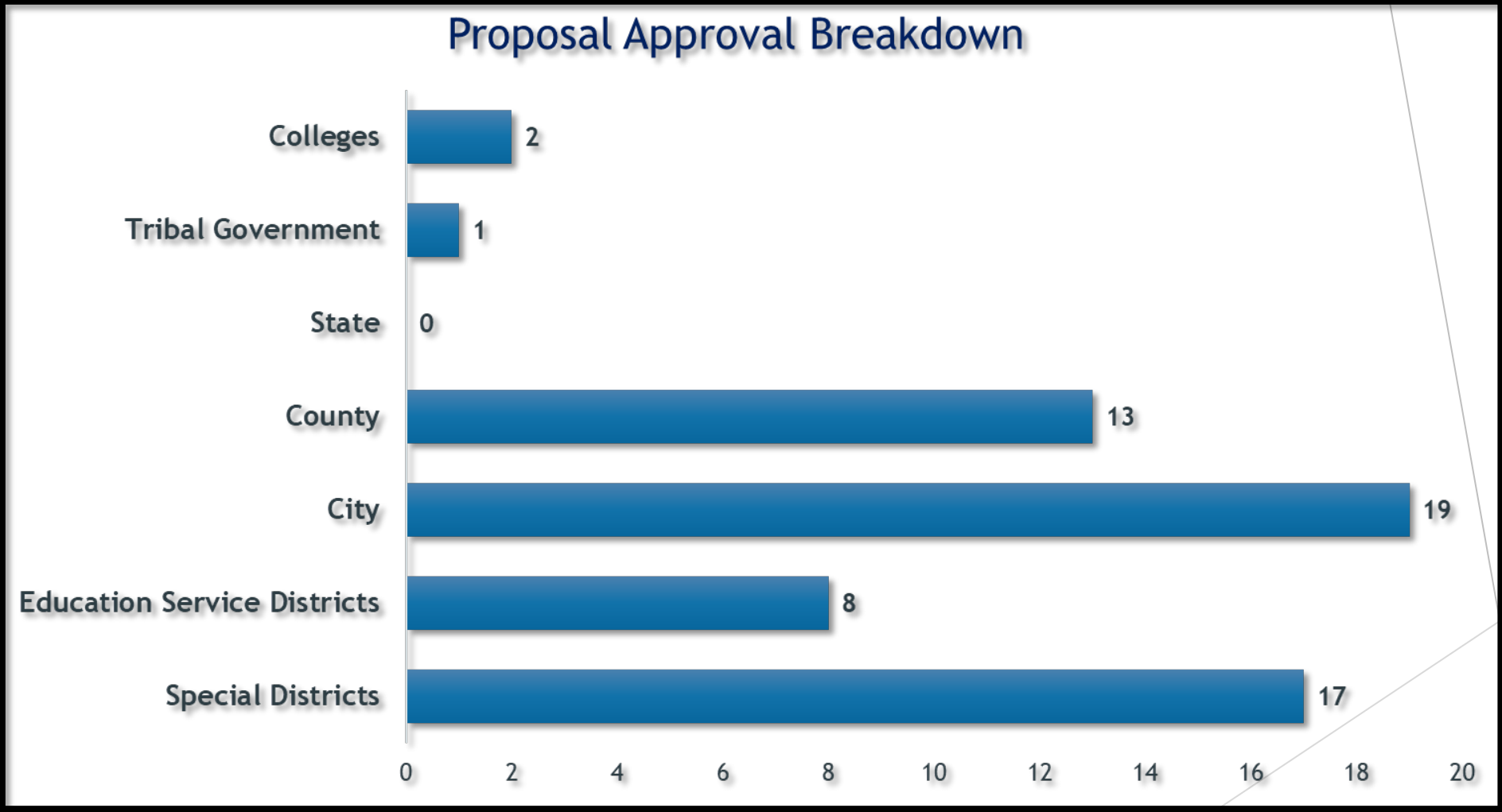


# IIJA SLCGP: FFY22 – FFY23 Registration Breakdown





# IIJA SLCGP: FFY22 – FFY23 Recommended Proposals



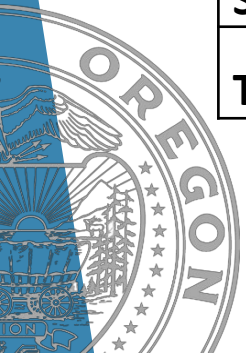
# IIJA SLCGP: FFY22 – FFY23 Allocated Spend Breakdown

**NOFO Funding Guideline:** As part of the 80% local government pass through requirement in obligating funds, items, services, capabilities, and/or activities, each SLCGP State Administrative Agency or multi-entity group is required to pass through at least 25% of the federal award amount to local jurisdictions within rural areas of the state or territory. Per 49 U.S.C. 5302 “rural” is any area with a population of less than 50,000 individuals. To meet the 25% rural pass-through requirement for SLCGP, the eligible subrecipient must be a local government entity within a rural area (a jurisdiction with a population of less than 50,000 individuals).

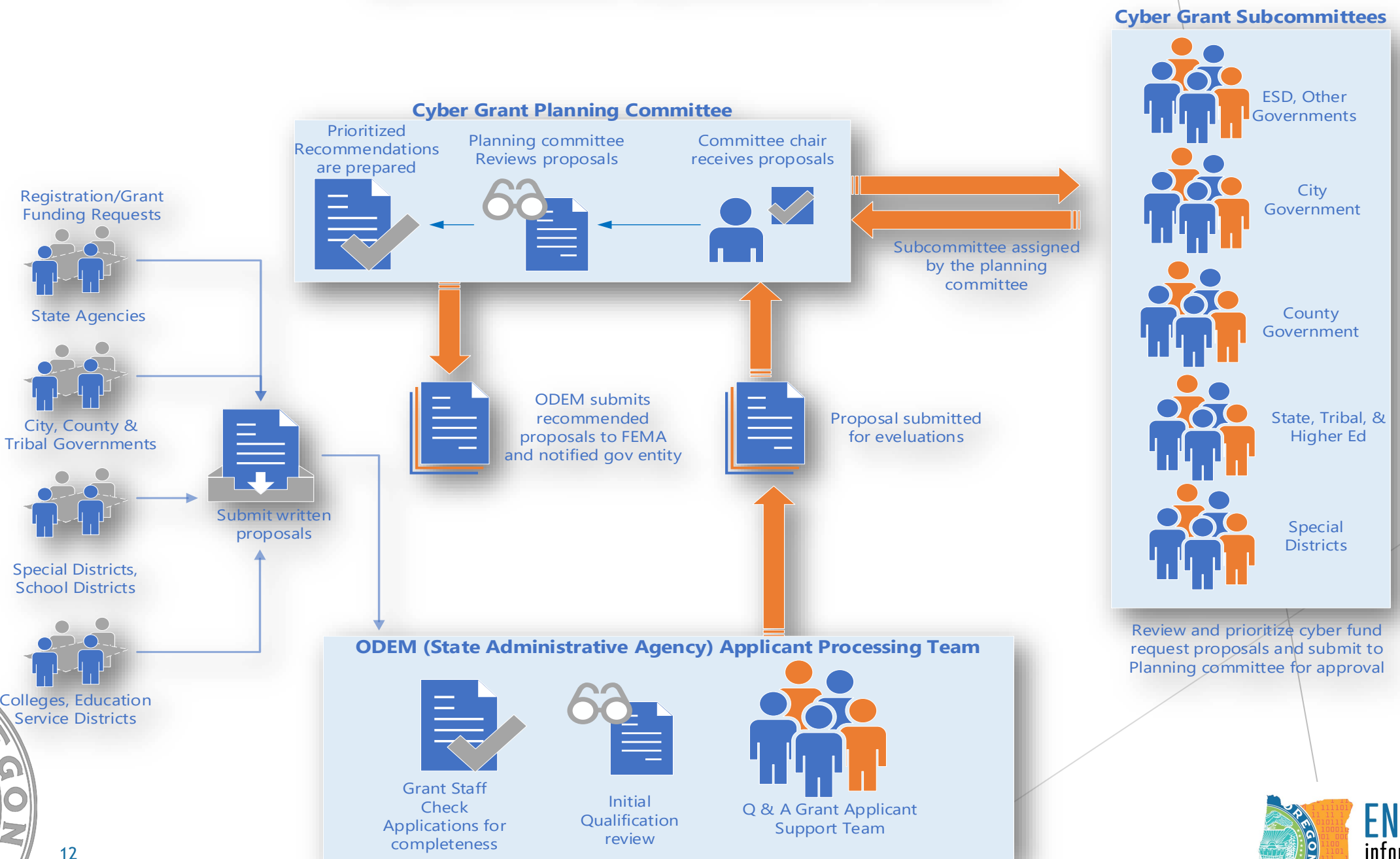
