## Digital Equity State Capacity Grant Program

<u>Purpose:</u> To promote digital equity and inclusion to ensure that all people and communities have the skills, technology, and capacity needed to reap the full benefits of our digital economy.

#### Where are we now:

- State Digital Equity plan -- approved 3/28/24
- Digital Equity State Capacity Grant Program application -- submitted 5/28/24

What's Next: Capacity Grant application curing with NTIA.



### **Digital Equity State Capacity Grant Program**

- Funding Allocation: \$9.9M (first of three funding allocations)
  - States must apply for funds in 2024, 2025, and 2026
- **Program Goal:** use federal digital equity funds to implement Oregon's approved Digital Equity Plan, specifically for the following eight covered population groups:
  - Low-income, older adults, veterans, incarcerated individuals, english learners and/or those with low levels of literacy, members of a racial or ethnic minority group, reside in rural areas.
  - 78% of people in Oregon fall into one of these covered populations.
