**RE: Support for the Appointment of Sara O'Brien as Executive Director of the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board**

Chair Lieber, Vice-Chair Knopp, and Members of the Committee:

On behalf of the Coalition of Oregon Land Trusts (COLT), we would like to share our strong support for the appointment of Sara O'Brien as the new Executive Director of the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board (OWEB). As a dedicated advocate for conservation and community engagement, Sara O'Brien brings the leadership qualities, expertise, and vision necessary to effectively steward Oregon's natural resources as the Executive Director of OWEB.

The Coalition of Oregon Land Trusts (COLT) is a network of 31 organizations working to protect Oregon's natural world - our water, wildlife, and open spaces - for all people, forever. Together, our statewide community of land trusts, soil and water conservation districts (SWCDs), and conservation organizations have protected more than 290,000 acres of land. Our land trust community works in close partnership with OWEB to protect and restore habitat, build climate resilience in our communities, and advance the goals of the Oregon Conservation Strategy.

As our state tackles the challenges of mitigating climate change, OWEB is a critical funding partner for our members to implement large-scale conservation and restoration projects on the ground with community buy-in and support. Sara is uniquely positioned to take these challenges head on. As the Executive Director of the Willamette Partnership, Sara brings to this position years of experience in collaborative governance, building partnerships with a wide variety of
