

Jail MOUD Program Technical Assistance

The challenges, and solutions

- Jail healthcare at capacity
 - implement high efficiency MOUD programs
 - integrate telehealth and community prescribers
 - assistance for Buprenorphine injectables
- High complexity of delivering buprenorphine (due to fentanyl), and methadone (regulations) in jail contexts
 - Addiction medicine faculty are expert clinicians and educators
- Punitive responses to SUD and diversion of MOUD
 - Education in healthcare model of SUD



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Addiction Medicine ECHOs

Accessible learning collaboratives

- 1 hour Zoom sessions
- Once weekly for 1 quarter
- Short didactic by expert
- Engaging panel conversation and Q&A
- Resource library available

Broad audience of behavioral health and law enforcement

- Adverse childhood experiences and trauma
- Recovery and relapse
- Understanding medications for addiction treatment

- Translate national best practices to local communities
- Efficient partner referrals across agencies
- Need for continual feedback and quality improvement




OHSU-School of Public Health

Deflection Program Collapse


Poor results; loss of trust in the community and with law enforcement.

Meet the National Experts TASC's Center for Health & Justice




- Grounded in TASC's 46+ years of experience in specialized justicehealth case management
