As a resident of the St. Johns neighborhood in North Portland. I write to urge that funding and resources be provided to ensure viable evacuation routes - in the event of a Cascadia Subduction Zone Earthquake. Such an earthquake would take out current evacuation routes, leaving us trapped and vulnerable.

Our safety is at risk - In the event of this earthquake, I do not want myself and my loved ones to be cut off from medical aid, or to possibly be trapped within a toxic cloud from the industrial zone. Our lives depend on the availability viable evacuation routes.

Please provide the funding necessary for: the rebuilding of the two Columbia Blvd bridges over the cut - and the feasibility study of work to be done on Lombard, plus the work itself.

Please address and fund all the resources necessary to make these routes viable for us.
