



Gilliam County Transportation

Gilliam County Transportation (GCT) provides transportation to the residents of Gilliam County Oregon. GCT operates out of the county seat in Condon. GCT is funded by State and Federal grants and rider donations. Small rural transportation entities rely heavily on grant funding sources to continue to provide safe, secure, available, and affordable transportation to seniors, veterans, low-income families, and all residents of the county.

Gilliam County Transportation operates primarily as a demand response service for medical appointments, shopping, and social opportunities. Continued funding will maintain these services and aid in the creation of planned scheduled excursions for shopping and social opportunities.

Gilliam County Transportation currently relies on 17 drivers and a fleet of 13 various purpose vehicles to ensure ADA available transportation for the riders represented in the following statics:

Average Monthly Riders

2022 Riders per month: 155

2023 Riders per month: 171

Gilliam County Transportation will combine riders and appointments into a single vehicle when scheduled appointments coincide in time and location. However, many of these appointments are located two to three hours away from the rider's residence and rarely coincide.

Gilliam County Transportation currently has vehicles stored in three different locations to protect and secure the equipment and office staff is not co-located. Grant funding has been secured for the opportunity to combine the facilities and office staff in Condon in one location in the future.
