

- You can get a <u>list</u> of the specific entities that received your data.
- You can <u>opt-out</u> (say "no") to a business selling, profiling, and using targeted advertising.
- You can get a <u>copy</u> of the personal and sensitive data a business has about you.
- K. -You can <u>know</u> what information a business has collected about you.
- E. -You can <u>edit</u> any inaccuracies in the data about you.
- **D**. -You can <u>delete</u> the data a business has about you.
