# HOME ENERGY REBATES

The U.S. Congress passed a large federal package known as the **2022 Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)** that includes several grants, tax incentives, and rebates designed to help consumers lower their energy use and save on energy bills. The Home Energy Rebates are a pair of programs that are available to states through the U.S. Department of Energy.

## HOMES

- Home Efficiency Rebate Program
- Performance-based rebates for energy efficiency retrofits

## HEAR

- Home Electrification and Appliance Rebate Program
- Rebates for high-efficiency electric appliances and certain associated upgrades

# REBATE FUNDING ALLOCATIONS

---

**HOMES:** Minimum of **\$45.8 million** available for rebates & incentives

- Low-Income allocation: at least 40%
- Low-Income multi-family allocation: at least 10%
- Funding set aside for Justice40 incentives & low-income audits

**HEAR:** Minimum of **\$45.6 million** available for rebates & incentives

- Low-Income allocation: at Least 60%
- Low-Income multi-family allocation: at Least 20%
- Funding set aside for contractor and Justice40 incentives




# PROPOSED DESIGN & IMPLEMENTATION DETAILS

---

- Engage two implementers:
  - Energy Trust of Oregon to implement in investor-owned utility areas
  - ODOE will issue an RFP for consumer-owned utility and Idaho Power areas
- Issue an RFP to procure a rebate processing and tracking system
- House Bill 3630 (2023) directed ODOE to create a “one-stop shop” for information about energy efficiency incentives and programs as part of our Home Energy Rebate work
  - Tentatively called the Hub for Information on Incentives Programs in Oregon (HIIPO)

# EMERGENCY BOARD REQUEST

---

**\$19.9 M** Limitation increase to launch phase 1 of the Home Energy Rebate Programs, which will allow launch of RFP processes and other education, outreach, and program design work

**0.33 FTE** Authority to establish a Program Analyst 3 to begin education and outreach efforts, which will include work on the hub for consumer information on energy efficiency rebates in Oregon
