

Acres Burned by Decade – All Jurisdictions










OREGON STATE FIRE MARSHAL UPDATE

- 17 conflagrations
- 27 Immediate Response & Pre-Position assignments
- EMAC mobilizations from four states
- Aircraft agreement with ODF





Structures threatened or lost

- 17,070 homes and 9,165 structures threatened
- 132 structures and 42 homes lost

Costs

- \$29.82 million Conflagrations
- \$4.77 million Immediate Response & Pre-Position
- \$34.59 total

- Oregon's Fire Mutual Aid System
- Immediate Response and Pre-position
- Engine Program
- 2024 Wildfire Seasonal Staffing Grant

Challenges

- Sustaining operational tempo and workload
