Funding: Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (\$689M)

<u>Purpose:</u> Develop broadband infrastructure capable of providing at least 100/20 Mbps to all locations in OR that are currently unserved and underserved.

Where are we now:

- 5-Year Action Plan approved
- Initial Proposal vol. 1 approved
- Initial Proposal vol. 2 approved
- BEAD Challenge Process results submitted to NTIA for curing

What's Next:

- Finalize Challenge Process locations
- Prequalification opens in November
- Final proposal due June, 2025




Challenge Process Stats

- Process began April 2024 and ended in August 2024
- 28 challengers filed 490 challenges
- 58,455 broadband serviceable locations challenged
- Preliminary Challenge Process results:
 - Approximately 127,000 locations BEAD eligible
