# Producer Responsibilities

The Recycling Modernization Act (RMA) requires companies that sell packaging, printing and writing paper, and food service ware into Oregon to work with a Producer Responsibility Organization (PRO) to share responsibility for the endof-life management of their products.

# Producer Requirements



#### Register: Now

- Register with CAA
- Sign Participant Producer Agreement and Oregon State Addendum
- CAA GUIDANCE: Instructions on CAA's website.



#### Report: March 2025

- Report material supply data to CAA by March 31, 2025
- CAA GUIDANCE: CAA reporting guidance on preparing data coming in Q4-2024



#### Pay Fees: July 2025

- Pay fees, associated with managing their packaging, to CAA
- CAA GUIDANCE: Utilize Sep 2024 program plan submission for fee estimates and internal budgeting. Receive published fees in Jun 2025

# **Existing Producer Resources**

CAA is committed to being transparent about the implementation process and to supporting producers in their EPR journey. Therefore, CAA has created a variety of educational, informational, and guidance resources.

# **Producer Reporting Guidance**

- CAA is developing reporting guidance for producers, coming in Q4 of 2024.
- The reporting guidance will be accompanied by access to a producer portal, where producers can initially find a producer registration form and necessary legal agreements. In future releases, the portal will include a reporting questionnaire to help producers determine if they are covered and, if so, in which states and a step-by-step process to input or upload data.

- · Monthly Producer Working Group (PWG) meetings for registered producers focus on complex producer compliance.
- Stakeholder Webinars, held quarterly for an extended stakeholder audience.
