- 1. Funding public transit. Maintaining frequent and reliable bus and train service is key developing a sustainable user base for these services. Giving people practical alternatives to cars should always be the first priority of the state's transportation policy.
- 2. Shutdown the Rose Quarter expansion. It's a corrupt boundoggle that fail to meet any of the its stated objectives while funneling fortunes of money into the pockets of paving contractors.
- 3. Take the IBR out of the hands of ODOT. Develop a professional and independent governance structure to keep the focus on building an earthquake resistant replacement and not as an opportunity to pave North Portland and South Western Vancouver.
