Prioritize things that will accelerate a transition to other modes of travel other than the private automobile. Electification of the existing automitive fleet will not solve the climate crisis. Our society must reduce its overall energy requirements. In the trasporation sector, it can only do that by moving toward modes of transportaion that move people around more efficiently. A side benefit of this transition will be a healther and happier societly.

And even setting the energy issues aside, the private automobile has contributed to the atomization of our socieity and the epidemic of loneliness. Its use is also inherently unjust. Only about 18% of the global population owns an automobile. Bascially, 4/5 the world suffers from the climate polution created by the wealthiest 1/5. It is truly a crime.
