Increase Transit Services: Dramatically enhance bus frequency and overall transit services to support the one in four Oregonians who cannot drive, ensuring better access to jobs, education, and healthcare. Invest in Safe Routes: Fully fund Safe Routes to School and other safety programs to create safe environments for walking and biking, particularly on dangerous roads like SE Powell and Hall Boulevard. Focus on Maintenance Over Expansion: Prioritize maintaining existing infrastructure and fixing roads and bridges instead of wasting resources on highway expansions like the Rose Quarter Freeway, which do not solve congestion and only increase pollution.

Address Climate Change: Implement a moratorium on freeway expansion and adopt policies aimed at reducing vehicle miles traveled to combat transportation-related carbon emissions, which account for 40% of Oregon's total emissions.

Support Community Initiatives: Invest in projects like the Albina Highway Caps, which enhance community well-being without exacerbating pollution.
