The Human Services Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board approve, retroactively, the submission of a federal grant application to the U.S. Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency, in the amount of \$13.3 million over a period of three years for shelter and support services for newly arrived migrants released from U.S. Customs and Border Protection custody.

The Department of Human Services would use the funds to provide grants to community-based organizations serving newly arrived migrants and establish a limited duration position to support grant administration.

The Department has recently been notified that Oregon will receive an award of \$2.8 million and will return to request any necessary Federal Funds expenditure limitation and position authority.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends approval.
