## Item 53: Department of Land Conservation and Development Collins Creek

The General Government Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board increase Federal Funds expenditure limitation for the Department of Land Conservation and Development by \$4.5 million for the Collins Creek land acquisition partnership.

The Department was awarded grant funding through the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration Coastal Zone Management Habitat Protection and Restoration Bipartisan Infrastructure Law program. Almost all funding will be passed on to the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Indians to purchase 42 acres of undeveloped land in Lincoln County. This land will remain undeveloped and be managed in perpetuity for its habitat, cultural, and climate resilience values. The Department will coordinate due diligence work and monitor that the property is held in conservation status.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends approval.
