The General Government Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board increase Other Funds expenditure limitation for the Department of State Lands by \$1,313,278 for redevelopment, planning, and maintenance of the Shutter Creek site.

The Department of State Lands received a federal earmark of \$4 million in Community Project grant funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development in December 2022 with no state match required. These funds are for redevelopment of the Shutter Creek site, which will be repurposed from a correctional facility to a location that could support administration and research staff along with community development opportunities in relation to the Elliott State Research Forest.

The Department's request represents the costs to partner with a consultant on a facility redevelopment plan and feasibility study, and for initial maintenance and repairs at the site.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends approval.
