## SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

## Consent Agenda – Various Agencies Requests for Approval to Apply for Federal Grants

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends that the Emergency Board approve the requests to apply for federal grants, en bloc, with the understanding that if the funds are awarded the agencies will return to the Legislative Assembly for approval of any necessary Federal Funds or Federal Funds as Other Funds expenditure limitation and position authority.

Fourteen state agencies seek approval to submit a total of 37 grant applications to various federal agencies. Of the 37 grant applications, all but one is retroactive. All agencies submitted the required advance notification to legislative leadership of their intent to apply for the grants.

State agencies seeking approval of grant applications include the Department of Transportation, the Department of Education, the Department of Fish and Wildlife, the Oregon Health Authority, the Department of Geology and Mineral Industries, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Emergency Management, the Department of Environmental Quality, the Department of Aviation, the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, the Department of State Lands, the Department of State Police, the Oregon Business Development Department, and the Teachers Standards and Practices Commission.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends approval, en bloc.
