I'd like legislators to help us break our addiction to automotive transportation and instead prioritize transit, cycling, walking, and other alternative modes. I've been commuting to work by bike for over 40 years, so I know it's possible to use other modes – in some cases. Our transportation network is so focused on cars and trucks that it's often IMPOSSIBLE to use other modes, even when we want to. You as legislators should think harder about how you not just enable but NECESSITATE automotive transport through the projects you fund. Thanks. – Peter
