# **OREGONSERVES COMMISSION**

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the OregonServes Commission subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

## **Appointment/Confirmation Authority**

ORS 660.500 (2023)

#### Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>

Not required.

## **Statutory Requirements**<sup>3</sup>

The commission consists of 15 to 25 Oregon residents, including:

- one individual experienced in educational, training and developmental needs of youth, particularly disadvantaged youth (CRUZ);
- one individual experienced in promoting involvement of adults 55 years of age or older in service and volunteerism (BASS);
- one community-based agency or organization representative (VACANT);
- the Deputy Superintendent of Public Instruction or designee (VACANT);
- one local governments representative (MCAFEE);
- one local labor unions representative (EDWARDS);
- one business representative (VACANT);
- one participant in, or supervisor of, a national service program for school-age youth, or of a campus-based or national service program, between 16 and 25 years of age (ALTAMIRANO);
- one national service program representative (CARPINELLO); and
- one volunteer sector representative (PALSHIKAR).

Membership may also include:

- educators, including a representative from a post-secondary institution of education and local education agencies (JONES, **HALL**, VILLEGAS);
- experts in the delivery of human, educational, environmental, or public safety services to communities and individuals (BARNES, CUMBERBATCH, PRUCH, SNEAD);
- members or representatives of Native American tribes;
- at-risk youths or out-of-school youths; and
- entities receiving assistance under the Domestic Volunteer Service Act of 1973.

Members serve three-year terms; an individual may represent more than one category required to be represented; no more than 50 percent can be of the same political party, and no more than 25 percent can be state employees. The commission selects its chair and vice chair and must meet once a quarter. Members must have a proven commitment to community service and a demonstrated interest in fostering and nurturing civic engagement as a strategy for strengthening communities and promoting the ethic of service in all sectors of this state.

#### **Duties**

The Corporation for National and Community Service (CNCS) is the federal agency that leads service, volunteering, and grant-making efforts under the AmeriCorps and Senior Corps programs.<sup>4</sup> States that establish a Service Commission are eligible to receive grants through those programs. The state commission develops a national service plan and administers national and community service programs.<sup>5</sup>

The commission must:6

- develop, oversee, and administer programs granted by AmeriCorps;
- apply to AmeriCorps for financial assistance for state-based service programs;
- develop a three-year, comprehensive national and community service plan;
- coordinate national and volunteer service in statewide activities for disaster preparedness, response and relief activities and climate mitigation;
- promote engagement in volunteerism; and
- biennially submit a report to the Governor and the Legislative Assembly.
