SUSTAINABILITY BOARD

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Sustainability Board subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Term

June 5, 2024 – December 31, 2027

Appointment/Confirmation Authority

ORS 184.427 (2023)

Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The board consists of:

- the Governor or their designee (VACANT); and
- 10 Oregon residents from around the state, from communities with the demonstrated ability to work collaboratively with people of diverse interests (BURKHOLDER, BROWNING, DIETRICH, HOLLIDAY, WILBURN), including individuals with experience in:
 - business (BOWLES, KELLY, PROUDFOOT);
 - natural resources (SHEPARD);
 - community health;
 - o economics;
 - sustainability (ANDERSON); or
 - o conservation of natural resources.

Members serve four-year terms, are eligible for reappointment, and must be removed for failure to maintain appointment requirements.

The Governor or their designee serves as the chair. The board selects its vice chair. A majority constitutes a quorum. The board must meet at least once every three months.

Duties⁴

The board encourages activities that best sustain, protect, and enhance the environment, economy, and community for the present and future benefit of Oregonians.

The board must:

- identify, evaluate, make recommendations, and propose legislation, regulatory changes, or policy modifications to agencies, the Governor, the Legislative Assembly, private entities, or other bodies;
- develop and promote policies and programs to meet sustainability goals;
- submit a biennial report to the Legislative Assembly;
- consult with trade associations, organizations, businesses, and other groups;
- develop and promote proposals that jointly and mutually enhance local economies, the environment, and community health; and
- administer the Sustainability Board Fund.

The board may:

- apply for, and accept, appropriations, gifts, or grants of money or other property; and
- adopt rules necessary for governing its operations and procedures.
