## **PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT BOARD**

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The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Public Employees Retirement Board subject to Senate confirmation.<sup>1</sup>

### **Re-appointee**

John Scanlan of Pendleton

### **Term**

May 14, 2024 – May 13, 2027

### **Statement of Economic Interest<sup>2</sup>**

Required.

### **Composition<sup>3</sup>**

The board consists of five Oregon residents, including:

- one state employee in management or a person who holds an elective office, by election or appointment, in the governing body of a participating public employer, other than the state (LINNEEN).
- one retired Public Employees Retirement System (PERS) member who retired from an appropriate bargaining unit, or a public employee who is in an appropriate bargaining unit and who has an exclusive representative (SCANLAN).
- three individuals with experience in business management, pension management, or investing (BUCKLEY, JARAMILLO, SHENOY).

The members with experience in business management, pension management, or investing may not be a PERS member or a beneficiary of a PERS member and may not have any interest in benefits provided by the system.

All members must be at least 21 years of age, be citizens of the United States, and have been Oregon residents for at least two years immediately preceding appointment. They have the same fiduciary duties and must exercise the same degree of independent judgment. Members serve three-year terms. The Governor designates the chair, who serves at the pleasure of the Governor.

## Duties

The board administers PERS, including retirement, death, and retiree health insurance benefits and the Oregon Savings Growth Plan.<sup>4</sup> The board must:<sup>5</sup>

- serve as trustee of the Public Employees Retirement Fund (PERF);
- arrange for actuarial service, including biennial actuarial analysis of the prospective financial condition of PERS and unfunded actuarial liability;
- employ a director and create other necessary positions;
- publish information regarding PERS health and performance;
- adopt rules and maintain qualification of PERS and PERF as a qualified governmental retirement plan and trust under the Internal Revenue Code;
- establish rules for transacting its business and administering PERS;
- provide for an annual audit of PERF and for an annual report to the Legislative Assembly and to all PERS members;
- appoint a committee to advise the board on related legislative proposals;
- establish an Unfunded Actuarial Liability Resolution Program to provide technical expertise to participating public employers; and
- administer and report to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means during each regular session of the Legislative Assembly on the Employer Incentive Fund.

The board may:

- adopt rules for the administration of the board's statutory provisions;
- conduct hearings, subpoena and examine witnesses, and require the production of any book, record, document, certificate, writing, article, or thing necessary to a determination of facts;
- accept gifts of money or other property from any source, given for the uses and purposes of the system; and
- review legislative proposals for changes in the benefits provided under the system and make recommendations to committees of the Legislative Assembly on those proposed changes.
