Statement of Economic Interest²

Not required.

Composition³

The board consists of seven members, including:

- one journeyman plumber with at least 10 years' experience (GILLETTE);
- one licensed plumbing contractor (NGUYEN);
- one local plumbing inspector who is a journeyman plumber (BERGEN);
- one registered professional mechanical engineer (FRAZIER);
- one officer or employee of the Oregon Health Authority (KELLER);
- one plumbing equipment supplier or one building official (MATIACO); and
- one public member (LEBOLD).

Members serve four-year terms. The board selects its chair and vice chair and must meet at least four times per year.

Duties⁴

The board regulates the practice of plumbing and advises the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services on the administration of the plumbing code. The board must:

- adopt rules for the administration of specified statutory provisions;
- establish and assess fees for specified services;
- review and recommend changes to the Plumbing Specialty Code;
- approve technical and scientific facts related to proposed material, design, or method of construction;
- approve alternative regulatory options for emerging technologies;
- receive and adjudicate appeals of suspected code violations, building official decisions, and municipal appeals board decisions;
- approve the adoption and amendment of the Plumbing Specialty Code;
- consult with the Director regarding alternative permit and inspection programs;
- select two members to serve on the Construction Industry Energy Board;
- consult with the Director on the adoption of uniform energy conservation standards and the Reach Code; and
- advise on standards, qualifications, and training for building officials and inspectors.

The board may:

- deny, suspend, condition, or revoke a registration, certification, or licensure; and
- assess civil penalties for violations of the laws.
