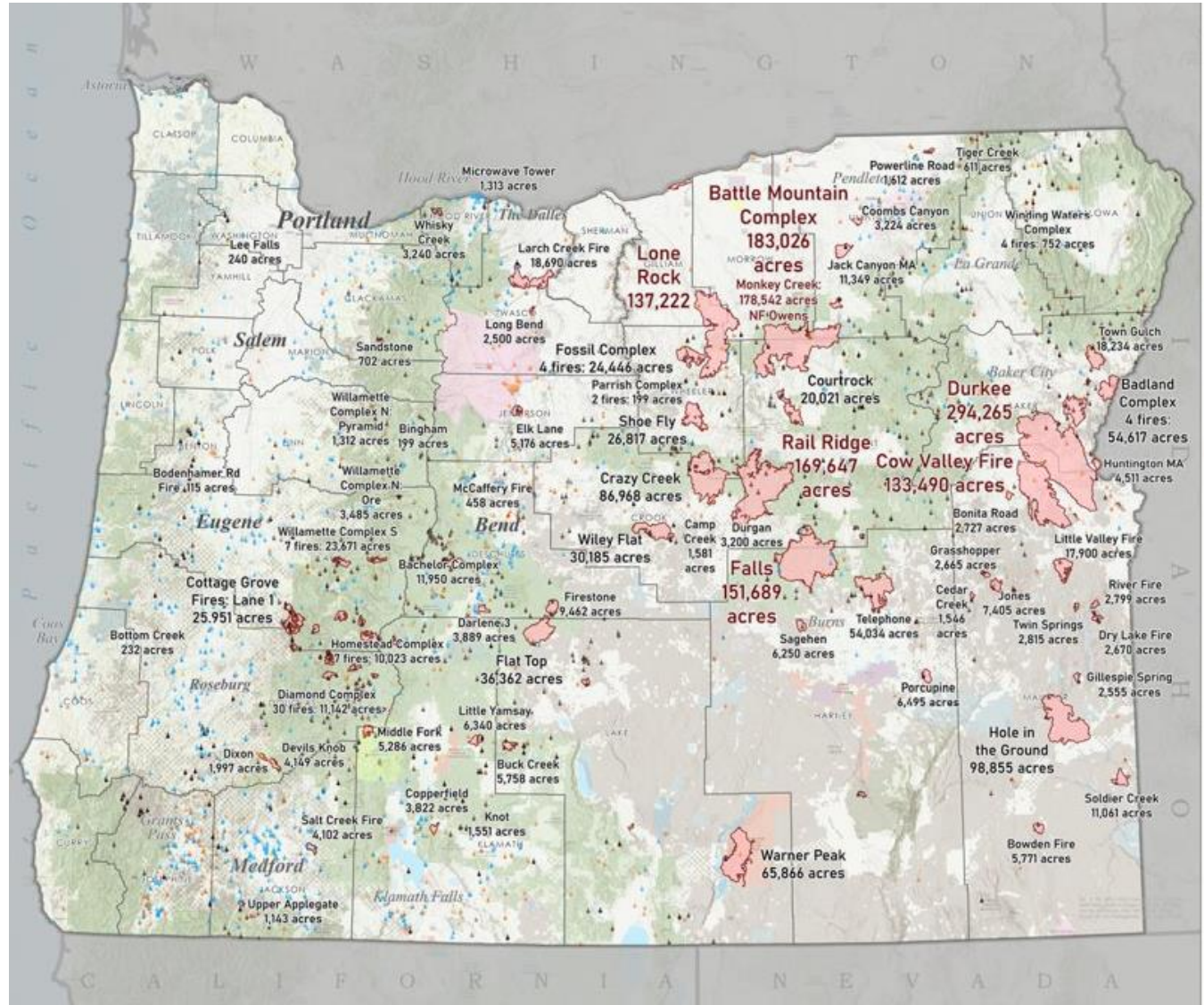

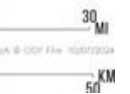

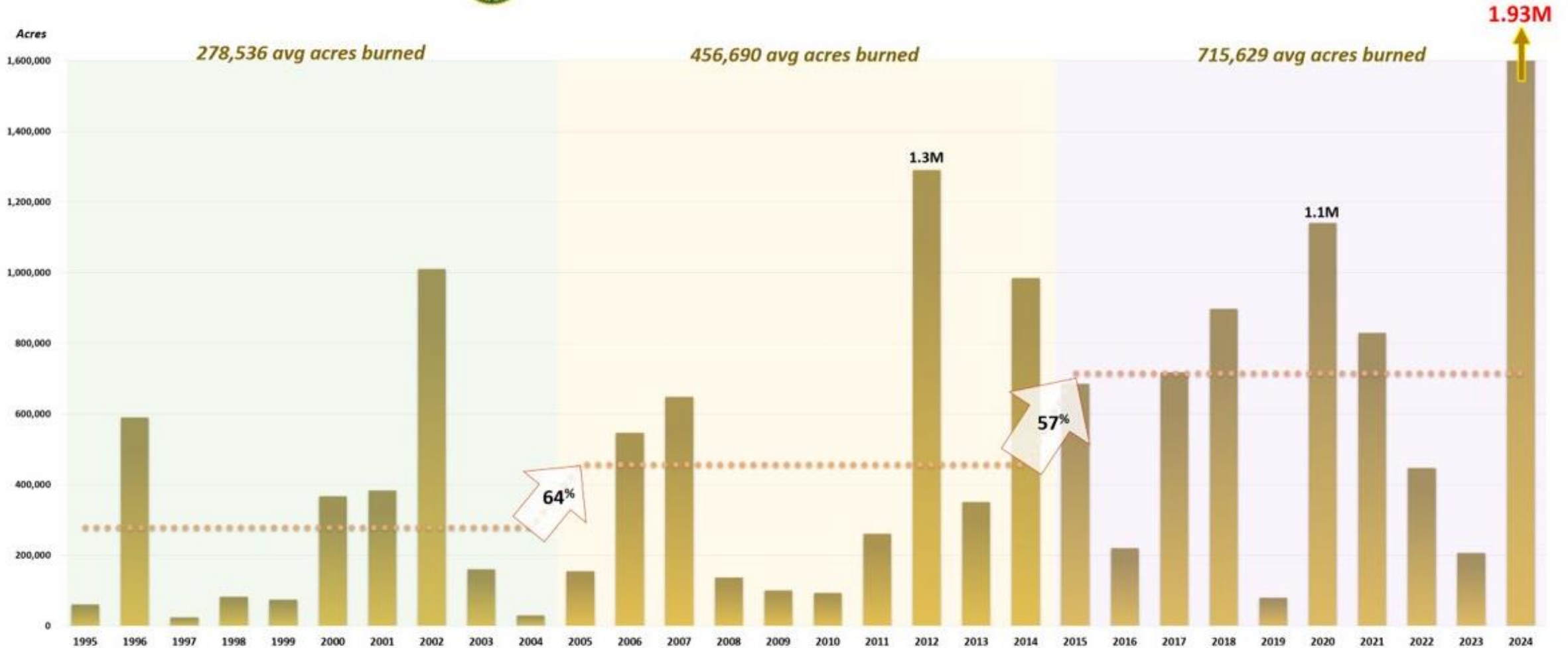


# ACRES BURNED BY DECADE – ALL JURISDICTIONS

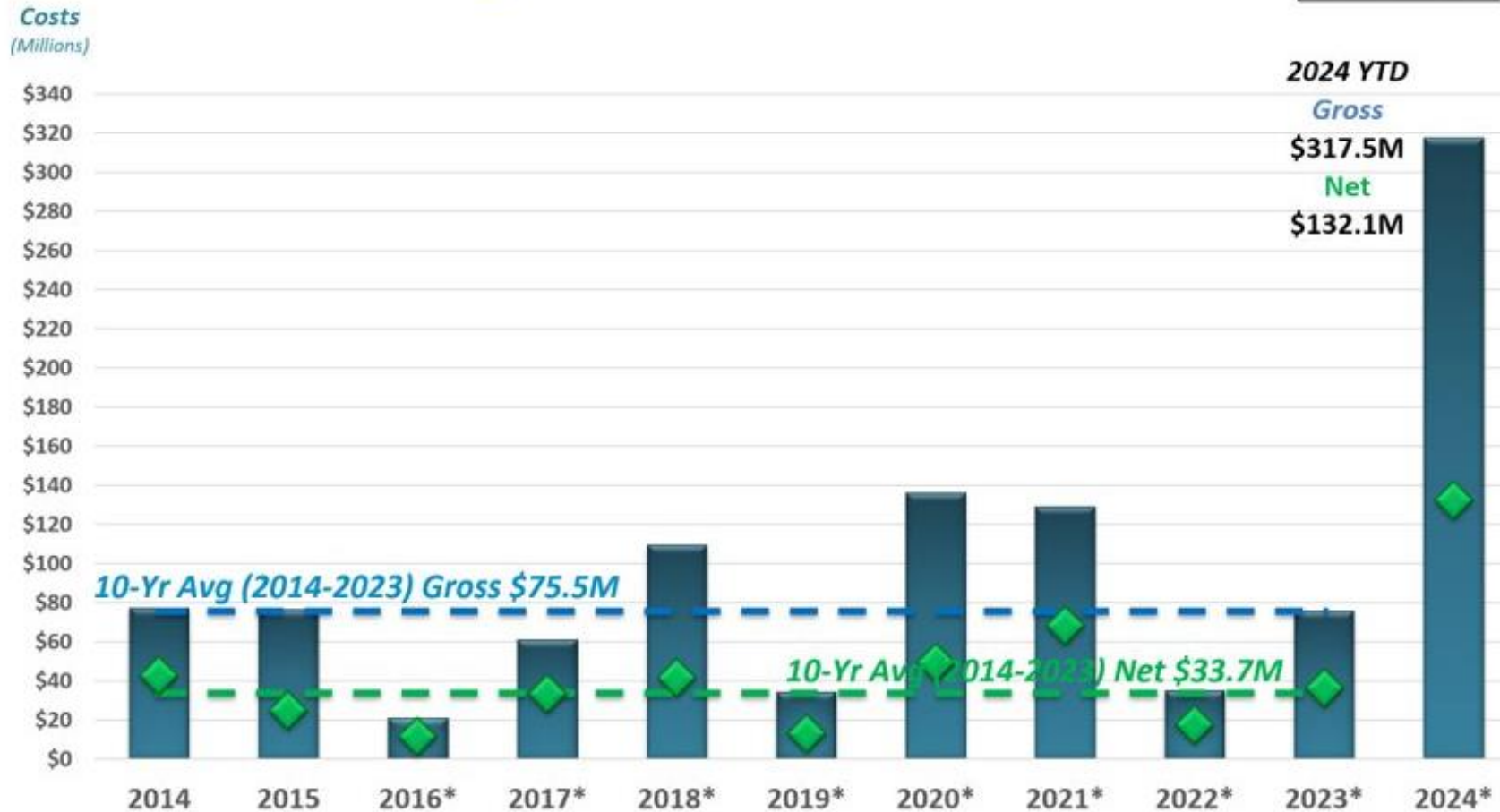

## ODF Large Fire Costs 2014 - 2024

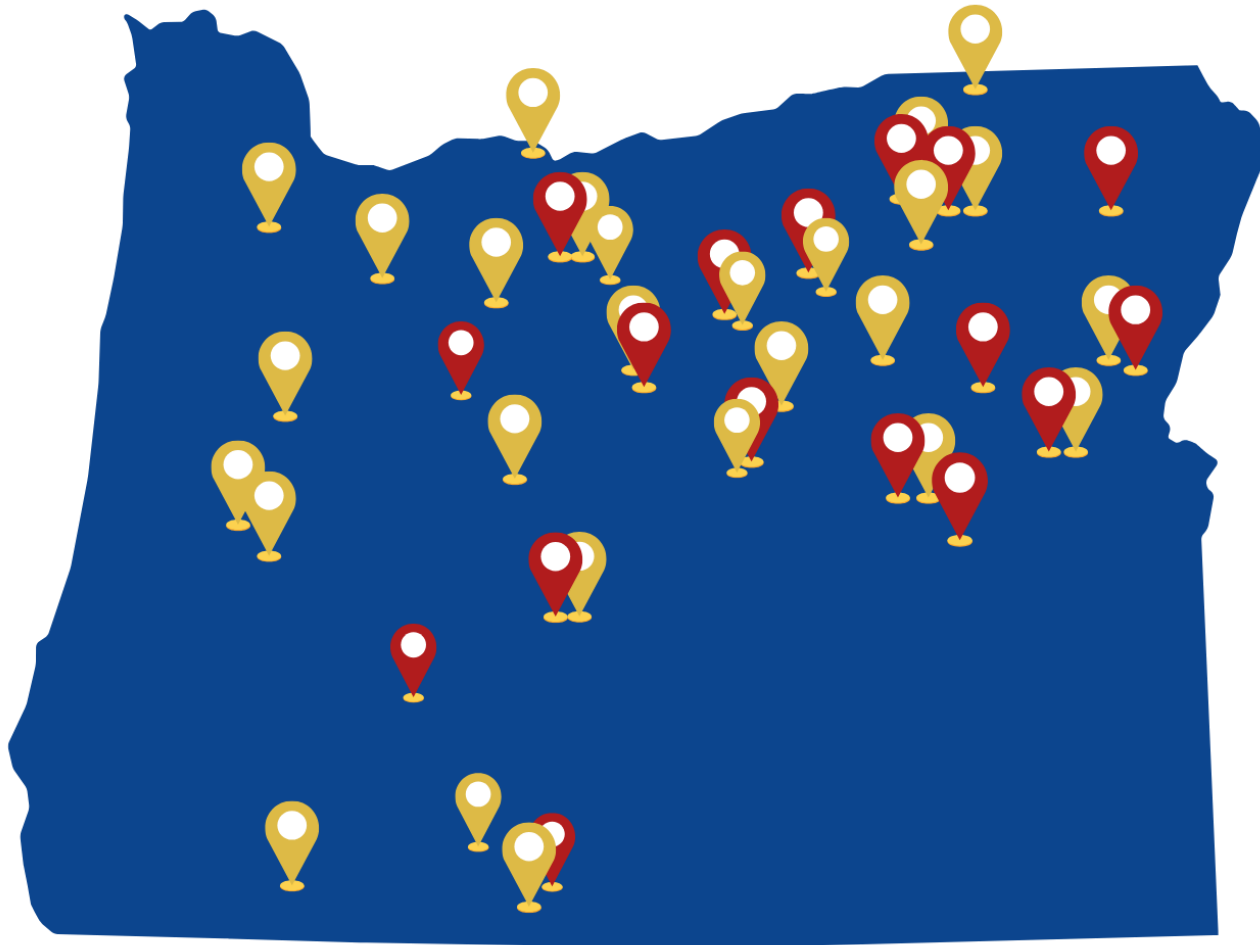

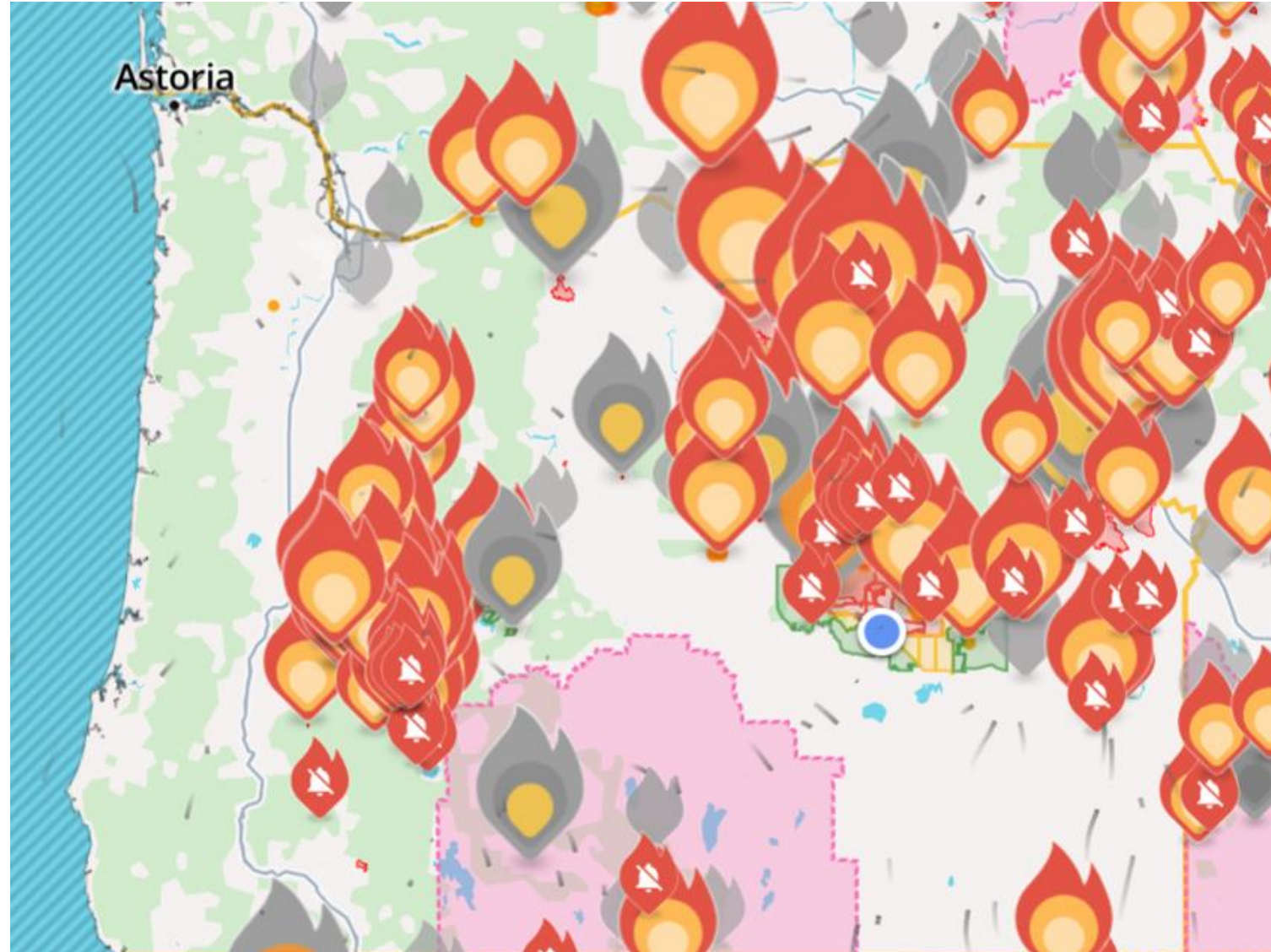
 CONFLAGRATION  IMMEDIATE RESPONSE & PRE-POSITION

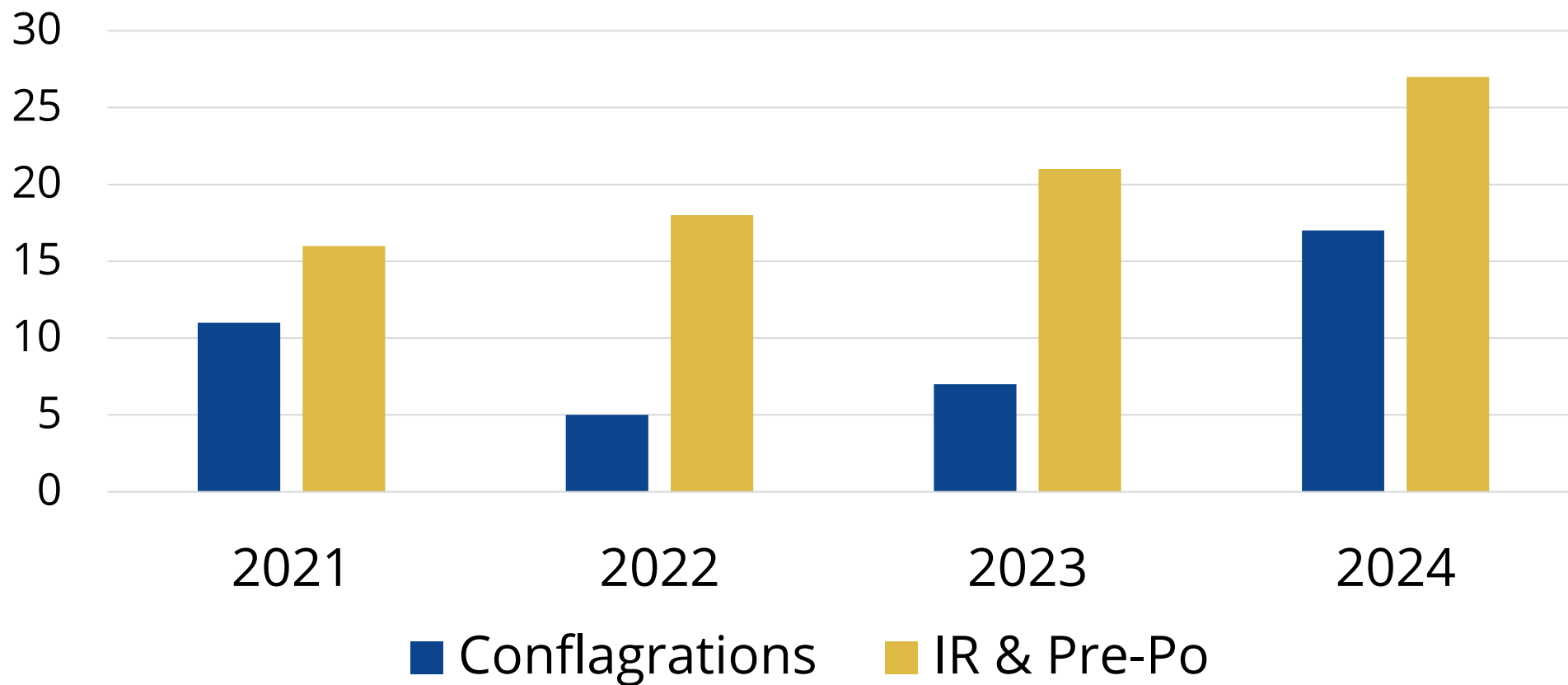

# FIRE SEASON COSTS

## STRUCTURES THREATENED OR LOST

- 17,070 homes and 9,165 structures threatened
- 132 structures and 42 homes lost

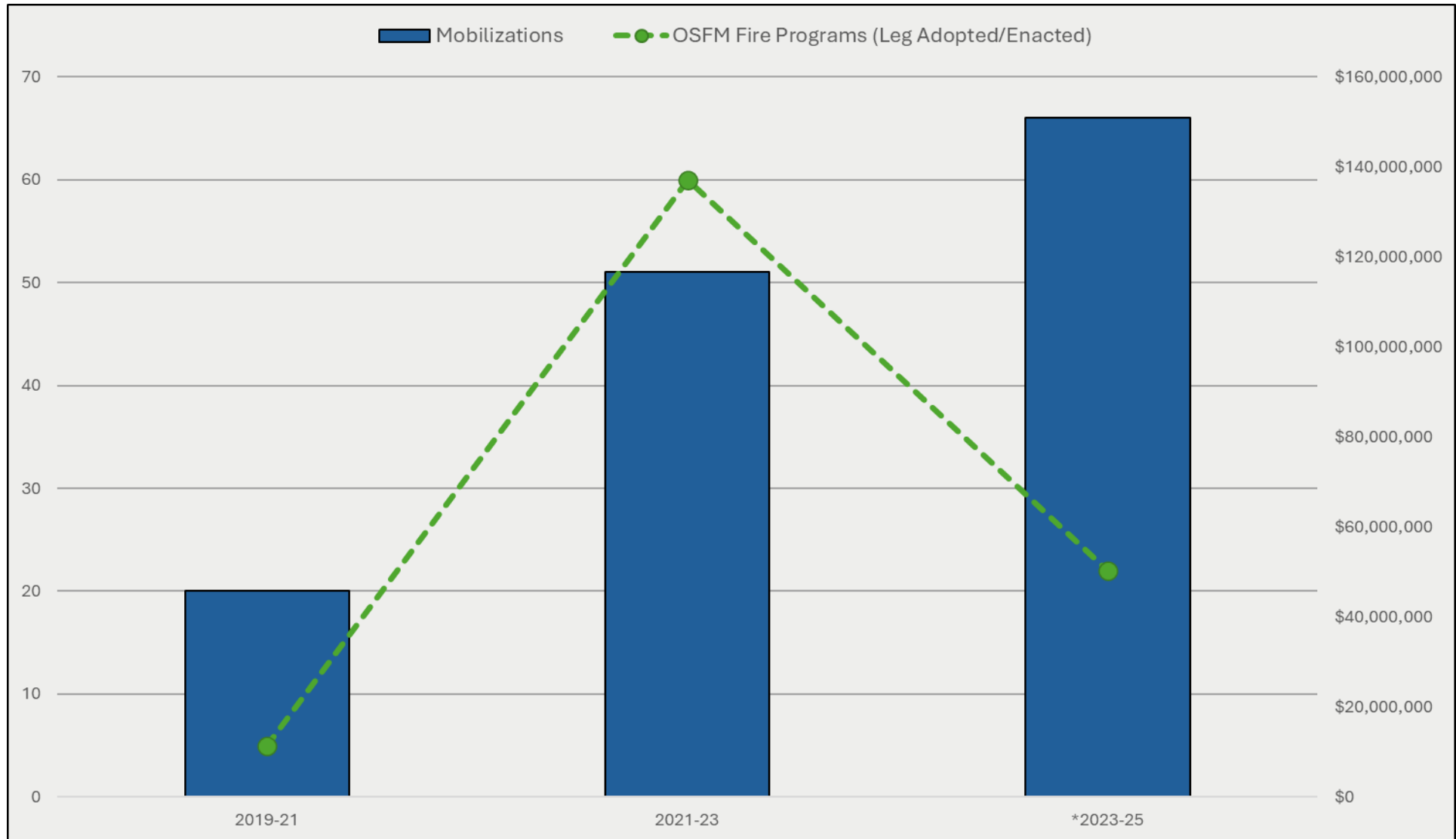
## COSTS

- \$29.82 million – Conflagrations
- \$4.77 million - Immediate Response & Pre-Position
- **\$34.59 total**
