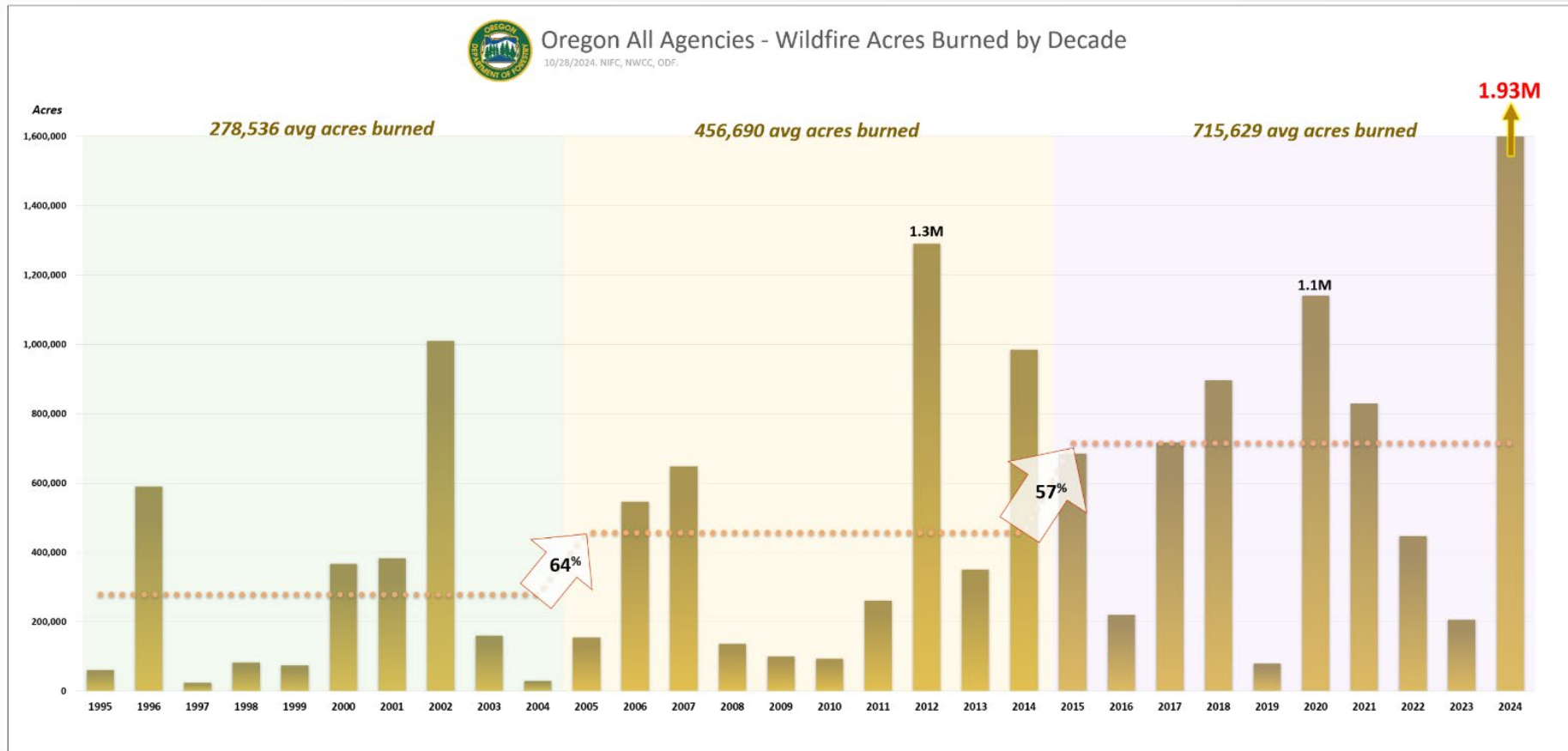

Acres Burned by Decade – All Jurisdictions



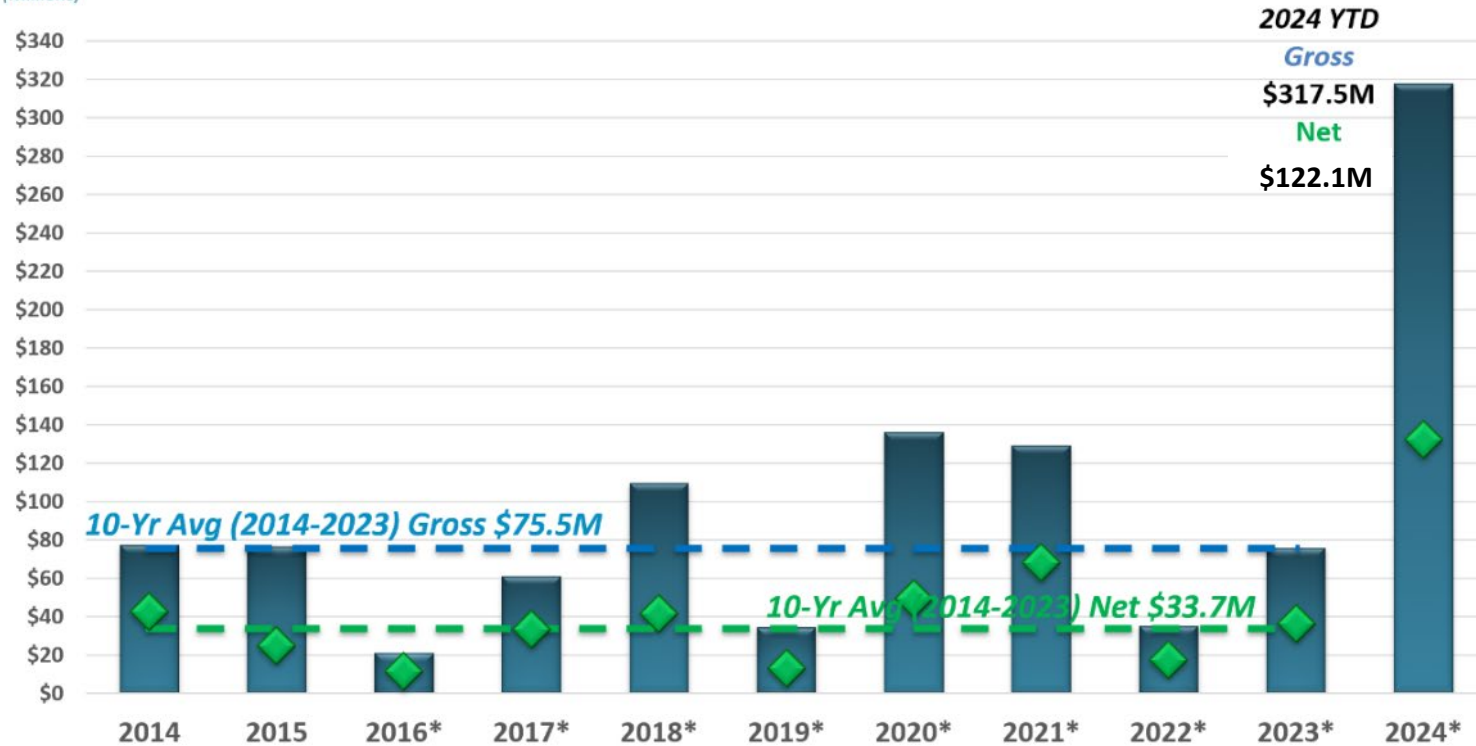


ODF Large Fire Costs 2014 - 2024

E-Board Request
