SUMMARY

Digest: The Act creates the Veterans Waiver Program. (Flesch Readability Score: 66.7).

Establishes the Veterans Waiver Program in the Oregon Health Authority to provide, beginning in 2026, medical assistance to low-income veterans who reside in Oregon.

Declares an emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

- Relating to veterans; creating new provisions; amending ORS 406.140; and 2 3 declaring an emergency.
- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4
- SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section: 5

- (a) "Medical assistance" has the meaning given that term in ORS 6 414.025. 7
- 8 (b) "Veteran" means an individual who is a veteran, as defined in ORS 408.225, except the individual may be discharged or released under honorable or other than honorable conditions.
- (2) The Veterans Waiver Program is established in the Oregon 11 Health Authority to provide medical assistance to veterans who are 12 residing in Oregon. 13
- (3) An individual is eligible for the Veterans Waiver Program if the 14 individual: 15
- 16 (a) Is a resident of Oregon;
- (b) Has income that is at or below 400 percent of the federal poverty 17 guidelines; and 18

- 1 (c) Is a veteran.
- 2 (4) The authority shall:
- (a) Prescribe by rule a simple application process for the Veterans
 Waiver Program.
- 5 (b) Provide assistance in person, by telephone or by online chat to applicants for and enrollees in the program.
- 7 (c) Require and accept as verification of eligibility:
- 8 (A) Documentation demonstrating that an applicant's income is at 9 or below 400 percent of the federal poverty guidelines.
- 10 (B) An applicant's federal DD Form 214 or 215.
- 11 **SECTION 2.** ORS 406.140 is amended to read:
- 406.140. There is established in the State Treasury, separate and distinct
- 13 from the General Fund, the Veterans' Services Fund, to be administered by
- 14 the Oregon Department of Administrative Services. Interest earned by the
- 15 fund is credited to the fund. Pursuant to Article XV, section 4f, of the
- 16 Oregon Constitution, one and one-half percent of the net proceeds from the
- 17 Oregon State Lottery shall be deposited in the Veterans' Services Fund. All
- 18 moneys transferred from the State Lottery Fund and all other moneys au-
- 19 thorized to be transferred to the Veterans' Services Fund from whatever
- 20 source are appropriated continuously to provide services for the benefit of
- veterans, including medical assistance under section 1 of this 2025 Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. (1) The provision of medical assistance through the
- 23 Veterans Waiver Program established under section 1 of this 2025 Act
- 24 shall begin on January 1, 2026.
- 25 (2) The Oregon Health Authority shall accept applications to enroll
- 26 in the Veterans Waiver Program beginning no later than November
- 27 **1, 2025.**
- SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
- 29 the amount of \$_____ is established for the biennium beginning July
- 30 1, 2025, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
- 31 moneys allocated from the Veterans' Services Fund established under

1	ORS 406.140 to the Oregon Health Authority for implementation of
2	section 1 of this 2025 Act.
3	SECTION 5. No later than July 1, 2026, the Oregon Health Authority
4	shall estimate the amount of funding needed to pay the costs of the
5	Veterans Waiver Program established under section 1 of this 2025 Act.
6	If the estimated amount needed exceeds the amount of moneys re-
7	maining in the Veterans' Services Fund established under ORS 406.140,
8	the authority shall include moneys necessary to cover the costs of the
9	Veterans Waiver Program in the authority's agency request budget,
10	as described in ORS 291.208.
11	SECTION 6. Section 5 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
12	SECTION 7. This 2025 Act being necessary for the immediate pres-
13	ervation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is de-
14	clared to exist, and this 2025 Act takes effect July 1, 2025.
