SUMMARY

Digest: This Act tells ODOE to create and implement an action plan for fuel storage. (Flesch Readability Score: 77.8).

Directs the State Department of Energy to develop and implement a Statewide Geographic Diversity of Fueling Stations for Disaster Reserves Priority Action Plan.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to statewide fuel storage capacity; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Energy, in cooperation**
5 **with the Department of Environmental Quality and the Department**
6 **of Land Conservation and Development, shall develop an action plan,**
7 **to be known as the Statewide Geographic Diversity of Fueling Stations**
8 **for Disaster Reserves Priority Action Plan.**

9 **(2) The action plan shall be based on the 2024 Oregon Energy Se-**
10 **curity Plan, and any subsequent updates to the security plan, and in-**
11 **clude:**

12 **(a) Strategies to increase the geographic diversity of liquid fuel**
13 **storage by region in Oregon;**

14 **(b) Strategies to improve statewide liquid fuel reserves to support**
15 **response and recovery activities; and**

16 **(c) A prioritized list of locations for expanding storage capacity at**
17 **existing fuel storage sites or developing fuel storage capacity at sites**
18 **where there is not currently fuel storage.**

1 **(3) The action plan must take into account:**

2 **(a) Any negative impacts on the environmental health of commu-**
3 **nities in areas identified for new or expanded fuel storage capacity;**
4 **and**

5 **(b) The potential for reliance on fossil fuels to decline and the im-**
6 **port on the action plan resulting from that decline.**

7 **(4) Upon completion of the action plan, the State Department of**
8 **Energy may, subject to available funding, take any actions within the**
9 **authority of the department necessary to implement the action plan.**

10 **(5) The department shall review and update the action plan no less**
11 **than once every five years.**

12 **SECTION 2.** **The State Department of Energy shall submit the**
13 **action plan developed under section 1 of this 2025 Act in a report to**
14 **the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to energy,**
15 **in the manner provided under ORS 192.245, no later than September**
16 **15, 2026. The report may include recommendations for legislation nec-**
17 **essary to implement the action plan.**

18 **SECTION 3.** **This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date**
19 **on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative As-**
20 **sembly adjourns sine die.**

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
