Going Home II Services

Intensive Case Management: Support high-risk individuals and families.

Incident Response: Prevent retaliation with law enforcement and CBOs.

Family Support: Provide relocation, mental health, and funeral aid.

Conflict Mediation: Resolve disputes and relocate as needed.

Evaluation: Track impact with Gresham partnerships.

Community Resources: Address gang-affiliated needs locally.
