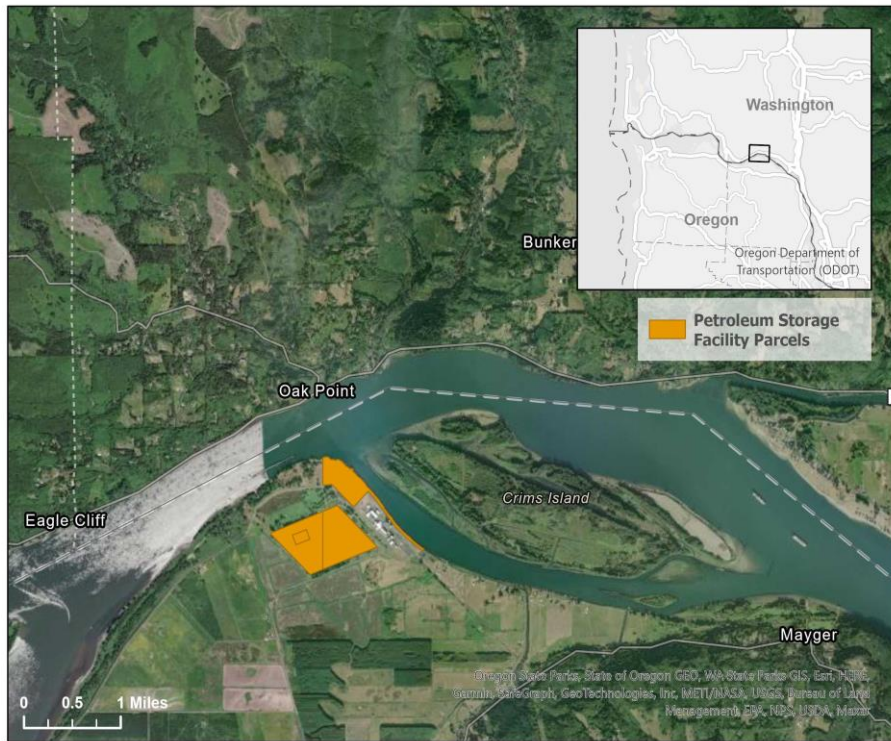

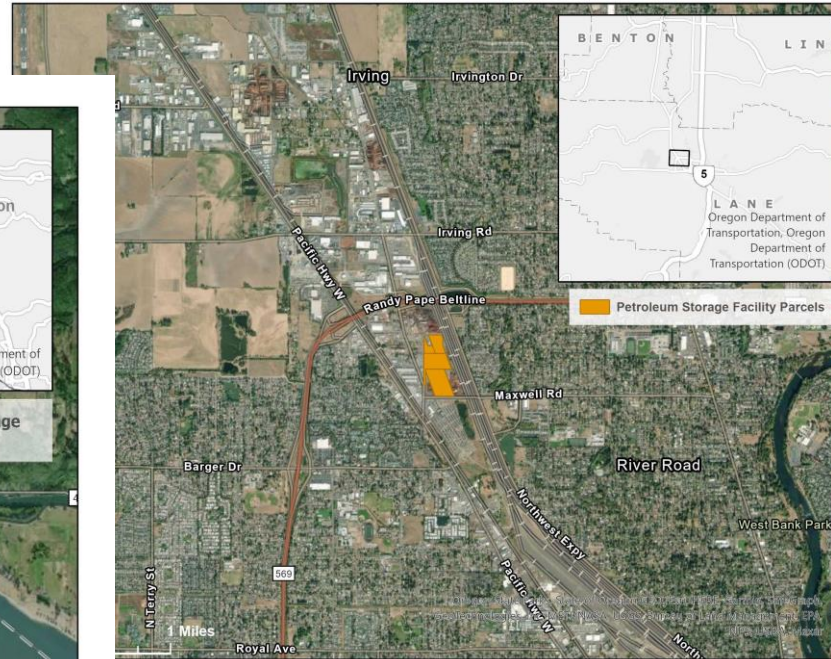

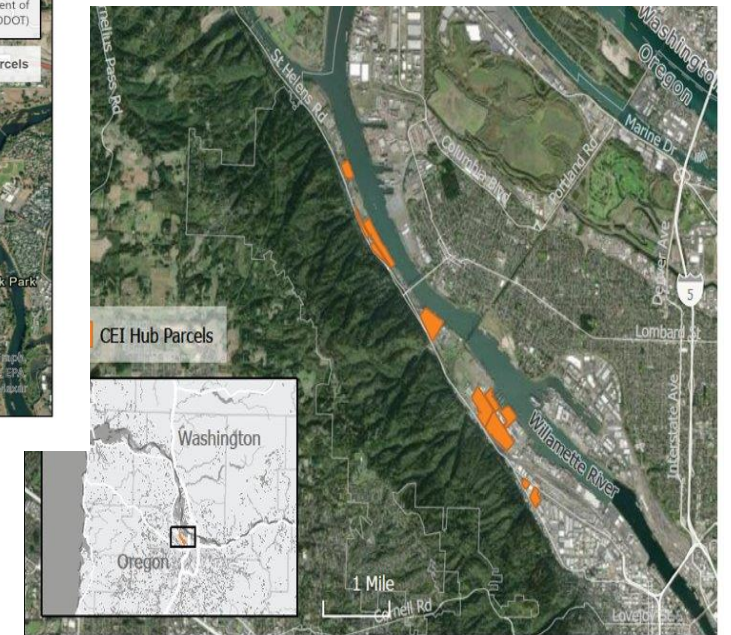

- Twelve are providing additional information



Proposed Policy Options

- Expand the program statewide
- Lower the capacity from 2 mil to 1 mil. gal. statewide
- Statewide study of risk from smaller facilities
