A summary of capacity across SUD Residential Services, Withdrawal Management Facilities, Secure Residential Facilities, Residential Facilities, and Residential Homes:

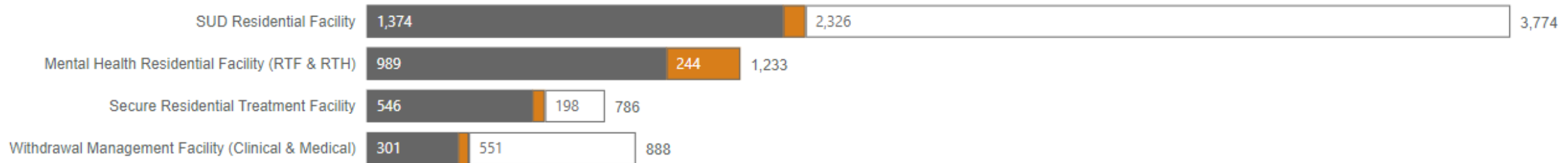

Bed capacity by facility type

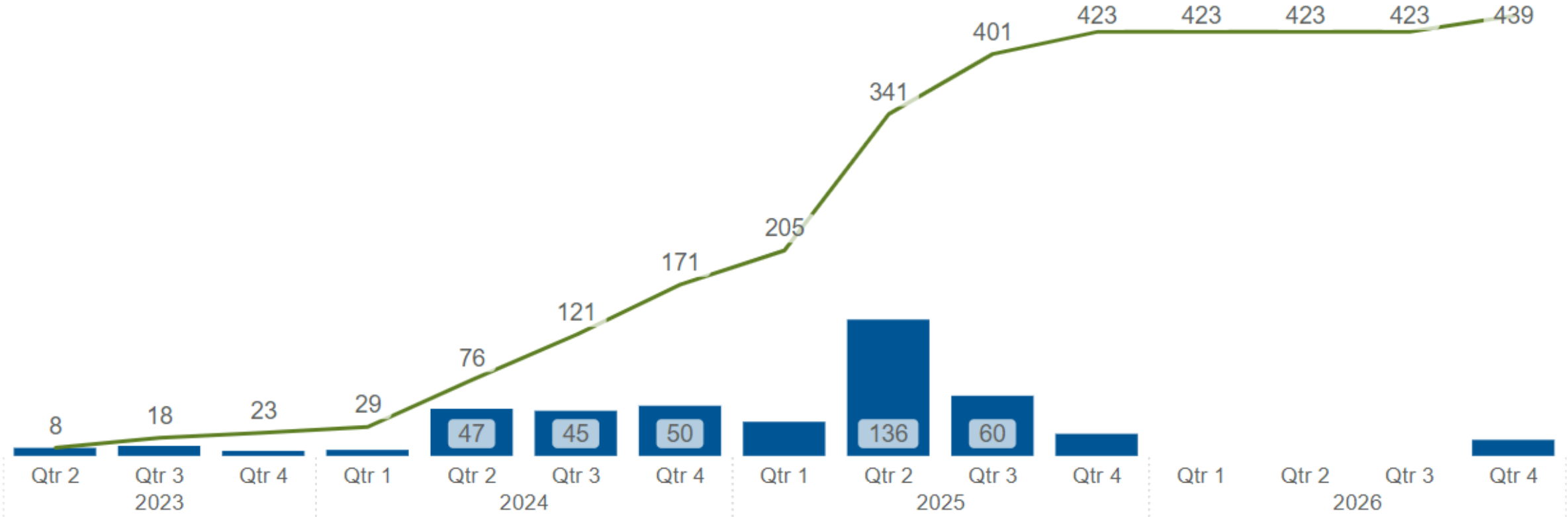

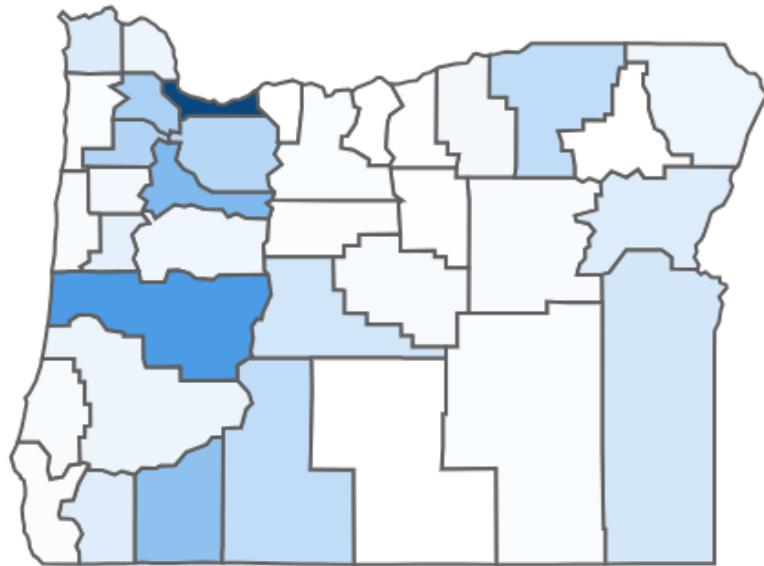

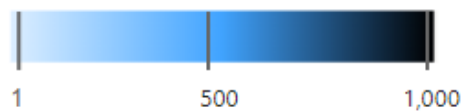

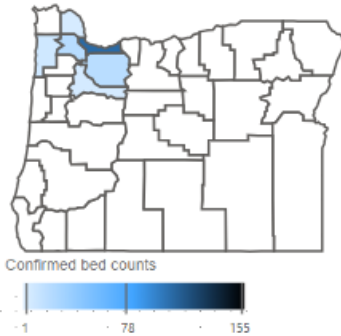
