SUMMARY

Digest: The Act would extend the property tax break for multiunit rental housing. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.7).

Extends the sunset date for the property tax exemption for multiunit rental housing.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

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- Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 4, chapter 624, Oregon Laws 2017, is amended to read:
- 8 **Sec. 4.** (1) Sections 1 to 3 [of this 2017 Act], **chapter 624, Oregon Laws** 9 **2017,** are repealed on January 2, [2027] **2033**.
- 10 (2) Notwithstanding the date specified in subsection (1) of this section,
- 11 eligible rental property that is granted exemption under an ordinance or re-
- 12 solution adopted pursuant to section 1 [of this 2017 Act], chapter 624,
- 13 Oregon Laws 2017, before the date specified in subsection (1) of this section
- 14 shall continue to receive the exemption under the provisions of the ordinance
- 15 or resolution for the period of time for which the exemption was granted.
- SECTION 2. This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date
- on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative As-
- 18 sembly adjourns sine die.

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
