SUMMARY

Digest: The Act would have the Legislative Revenue Officer look at how our state and local taxes interact. The Act would have the officer submit a report on the study that suggests changes to the laws. (Flesch Readability Score: 60.9).

Requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to study the interdependence of the state and local tax systems in Oregon. Directs the officer to submit a report, with recommendations for legislation, to the legislature not later than September 15, 2026.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the interdependence of the state and local tax systems in Oregon;

3 and prescribing an effective date.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Legislative Revenue Officer shall conduct a study 6 of the interdependence of the state and local tax systems in Oregon. 7 Not later than September 15, 2026, the officer shall submit a report of 8 the findings of the study, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to 9 the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to reve-10 nue, and shall include recommendations for legislation in the report.

11 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.

12 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2025 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date 13 on which the 2025 regular session of the Eighty-third Legislative As-14 sembly adjourns sine die.
