SUMMARY

Digest: The Act would require a study of whether a single law for making adjustments for inflation in the tax laws of this state would be feasible and useful. The Act would require a report of the study to be turned in next year. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.9).

Requires the Legislative Revenue Officer to study the feasibility and utility of enacting a single statute that uniformly governs adjustments for inflation in the tax statutes of this state. Directs the officer to submit a report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to revenue no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Legislative Revenue Officer shall study the feasi-5 bility and utility of enacting a single statute that uniformly governs

7 shall submit a report of findings to the interim committees of the

8 Legislative Assembly related to revenue in the manner provided under

9 ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2026.
