




## OREM warming/cooling/cleaner indoor air grant

Klamath County School District Bonanza School Gymnasium, \$150,000 grant




### **OREM** air scrubbers

- 162 in OREM warehouse




### **OREM** resilience infrastructure

Evacuation assembly point equipment caches located in:


- Tillamook

- Coquille Indian Tribe, Coos Bay






### **Thrive Umpqua**
