RE: 2025 Committee LC Summaries

Date: December 10, 2024

LC 0161 Repeals the statutes that authorize involuntary commitment of an individual based on an intellectual disability and prohibits the denial of services related to mental illness on the basis of intellectual disability.

LC 0789 Establishes a task force on the recruitment and retention of case managers and adult protective services workers.

LC 1286 Requires the Department of Human Services to study the recommendations from the rate and wage study.

LC 1465 Requires the Department of Human Services to study the demographics of children in Oregon.

LC 1480 Requires the Department of Human Services to study developmental disabilities services.

LC 2041 Permits residents of long term care facilities, residential care facilities and adult foster homes to use an electronic monitoring device in their private quarters.

LC 2070 Requires the appointment of court appointed special advocates to certain advisory councils, advisory committees, and review teams.

LC 2419 Permits the Department of Human Services to revoke a license, certificate, or endorsement of any provider of community-based services to individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities if the provider is deemed unqualified, specifies circumstances.

LC 3464 Requires the Department of Human Services to study regulatory responses to violations of staffing requirements in long term care facilities and other state-regulated programs.

LC 3612 Modifies provisions to allow, but not require, the Department of Human Services to include a website for electronic reports of suspected child abuse.
