SUMMARY

Digest: The Act directs the OJD to study how to improve court access for victims of domestic violence in this state. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.8).

Requires the Judicial Department to study options for improving court access for victims of domestic violence in this state. Directs the department to submit findings to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary not later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets on January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to domestic violence.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> The Judicial Department shall study options for improving court access for victims of domestic violence in this state. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2026.

10 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
