Rap Back: What It Is


Rap Back is a service managed by the FBI that continuously monitors enrolled individuals' fingerprints for future criminal activity in the U.S.

Benefits:


- Improved Safety: Near real-time alerts if an enrolled individual is arrested.
- Reduced Burden: Eliminates the need for repeated background checks when reapplying for employment, licenses, or certifications.

Annual Received Background Check Requests




Forecasted New Requests With Rap Back



Implementation Planning

- **Implementation Date:** Oregon State Police ready by January 1, 2025.
- **Efficiency:** Standardized recheck cycle ensures smooth enrollment without disrupting current processes (ODHS|OHA).
- **Enrollment:** Requires fingerprint-based background checks (currently 33%, will increase to 100% with Rap Back).
- **Fiscal Impact:** Subscription fees and increased checks will raise costs (assessment ongoing).
