SUMMARY

Digest: The Act tells the CJC to do a study. (Flesch Readability Score: 100.0).

Directs the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study recidivism rates of persons granted a pardon and to provide the results of the study to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2026.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

Relating to pardons.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall study recidivism rates of persons granted a pardon.

(2) The commission shall provide the results of the study, including any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2026.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
