SUMMARY

Digest: The Act tells the CJC to do a study. (Flesch Readability Score: 100.0).

Directs the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission to study the effect of sentencing types on recidivism rates of sex offenders, and to provide the results of the study to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly no later than December 31, 2026.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to sex offenses.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall 5 study the effect of different types of sentences on recidivism rates of 6 sex offenders.

7 (2) The commission shall provide the results of the study, including 8 any recommended legislative changes, in a report to the appropriate 9 interim committees of the Legislative Assembly in the manner pro-10 vided under ORS 192.245 no later than December 31, 2026.

11 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Section 1 of this 2025 Act is repealed on January 2, 2027.
