## State Funding for School Facility Improvements

### **Oregon Department of Education**

- Oregon School Capital Improvement Matching (OSCIM) Program
- Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER)
- Student Investment Account (SIA)

### **Other State Agencies**

- Business Oregon's Seismic Rehabilitation Grant Program
  - > \$2.5 million grants for seismic resilience
- Oregon Department of Energy's Public Purpose Charge (SB 1149) Schools Program
  - Grants to improve energy efficiency

### ESSER & SIA

### **Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) Funds**

- Districts could use ESSER funds for both building renovations and new construction
- \$223.1 Million of ESSER funds spent on school facility improvements
- Expired Sept. 30, 2024

### **Student Investment Account (SIA) Funds**

• Restricted: Tied to overall plan of student achievement

Oregon Department of Education

Oregon School Capital Improvement Matching (OSCIM) Program

 Districts may be eligible for a \$6M - \$12M funding commitment

- OSCIM grant funds can be used for capital improvement projects
- Awarded grants over 18 election cycles

**OSCIM Grant Total** \$450,069,832 **Local Bond Total** More than \$7.8 Billion 99 OSCIM Grants Awarded 96 Districts have received an OSCIM Grant

# Statewide School Facility Assessment

- Started January 2024
- Surveying all ~4,800 education facilities
  - > FCA assessment
  - > ADA assessment
- Estimated completion June 2026 (Currently 20% done)
