LC 285: “Relating to aviation fuel”

Increases the tax on aircraft fuel usable in aircraft operated by turbine engines; adjusts the tax rate biennially according to any increase in the Consumer Price Index; takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

LC 735: “Relating to county safety corridors”

Makes permanent the county safety corridor program instituted by House Bill 3213 (2019 Session); authorizes counties to designate segments of highway with a higher-than-average incidence rate of crashes as safety corridors; limits designations to two safety corridors per county at any given time; specifies that fines for traffic offenses in safety corridors are doubled and establishes minimum fines for certain offenses; applies to offenses occurring on or after the measure’s effective date.

LC 1217: “Relating to vehicle weight limits:

Increases allowable weight limits for vehicles carrying fluid milk products to a maximum of 129,000 pounds.

LC 2675: “Relating to highways”

Transfers jurisdiction of Hall Boulevard, State Highway 141, to the City of Tigard. Transfers the portion of the Hood River Highway, Oregon Route 281, between the intersection with Pacific Avenue and the intersection with Oak Street, to the City of Hood River.
