## SUMMARY

Digest: The Act says that the state must give Hall Blvd. to the City of Tigard to look after and a part of the Hood River Highway to the City of Hood River to look after. (Flesch Readability Score: 67.3).

Transfers jurisdiction of Hall Boulevard to the City of Tigard and a portion of the Hood River Highway to the City of Hood River.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to highways; amending ORS 366.483.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** ORS 366.483 is amended to read:

5 366.483. (1) In accordance with ORS 374.329, the Department of Trans-  
6 portation shall transfer jurisdiction of the following state highways to the  
7 following cities:

8 (a) Pacific Highway West, State Highway 99, from the department to the  
9 City of Eugene. The department shall transfer the following two portions:

10 (A) The portion beginning where the highway intersects with the Beltline  
11 Highway and ending where the highway intersects with Washington Street,  
12 but excluding the bridge at milepost 121.42.

13 (B) The portion beginning where the highway intersects with Walnut  
14 Street and ending where the highway intersects with Interstate 5, but ex-  
15 cluding the bridge at milepost 126.02.

16 (b) Springfield Highway, State Highway 228 to the City of Springfield.

17 (c) **Hall Boulevard, State Highway 141 to the City of Tigard.**

18 (d) **Hood River Highway, Oregon Route 281 to the City of Hood**  
19 **River. The department shall transfer the portion beginning where the**

1 **highway intersects with Pacific Avenue and ending where the highway**  
2 **intersects with Oak Street.**

3 (2) Notwithstanding section 71d (4), chapter 750, Oregon Laws 2017, the  
4 department shall use the funds described in section 71d, chapter 750, Oregon  
5 Laws 2017, for the transfer of Powell Boulevard to upgrade the portion of  
6 Southeast Powell Boulevard beginning where the highway intersects with  
7 Interstate 205 and ending where the highway intersects with the city limits.  
8 After the upgrades are completed, in accordance with ORS 374.329, the de-  
9 partment shall transfer jurisdiction of the upgraded portion to the City of  
10 Portland. The department may upgrade and transfer portions of the highway  
11 in phases.

12 (3) In accordance with ORS 366.290:

13 (a) The department shall transfer jurisdiction of the portion of Territorial  
14 Highway, State Highway 200, that is located within Lane County from the  
15 department to the county. The department may transfer portions of the  
16 highway in phases. The department shall retain jurisdiction of bridges on  
17 Territorial Highway located at milepoints 4.59, 7.07, 17.92, 18.72, 18.98, 19.28  
18 and 25.49. The department shall transfer the jurisdiction of the bridges after  
19 the bridges are replaced.

20 (b) The department shall transfer jurisdiction of the portion of the  
21 Springfield-Creswell Highway, State Highway 222, beginning where it inter-  
22 sects with Jasper-Lowell Road and ending where it intersects with Emerald  
23 Parkway to Lane County. The department shall retain jurisdiction of bridges  
24 on Springfield-Creswell Highway located at mileposts 5.20, 5.41, 5.64 and  
25 13.36. The department shall transfer the jurisdiction of a bridge after the  
26 bridge is replaced.

27 (c) Lane County shall transfer jurisdiction of the portion of Delta High-  
28 way beginning where the highway intersects with Interstate 105 and ending  
29 where the highway intersects with the Randy Pape Beltline from the county  
30 to the department.

31 (d) Multnomah County and Washington County shall transfer jurisdiction

1 of the portion of Cornelius Pass Road beginning where the highway inter-  
2 sects with U.S. Highway 30 and ending where the highway intersects with  
3 U.S. Highway 26 from the counties to the department. The counties may  
4 transfer portions of the highway in phases.
