OREGON INVESTMENT COUNCIL

The Governor has appointed the following individual to the Oregon Investment Council subject to Senate confirmation.¹

Composition³

The council consists of six members, including

- four Governor appointees (AKINTORE, ARVIN, SAMPLES, WILSON-BODY);
- the State Treasurer (READ); and
- the Director of the Public Employees Retirement System (OLINECK), nonvoting, ex officio.

The council selects one member as chair.⁴ The State Treasurer is the investment officer. Governor appointees must be qualified by training and experience in investment or finance—one of whom may also be a member of the Public Employees Retirement Board. They serve four-year terms and are prohibited from accepting compensation for service on the board of directors of any business in which the state has an equity interest, other than publicly traded common stock.⁵

Duties⁶

The Oregon Investment Council oversees the investment and allocation of all State of Oregon trust funds. The council must

- write policies for the investment and reinvestment of moneys in the investment funds:
- diversify investments unless not prudent to do so;
- conform to the fundamental fiduciary duties of loyalty and impartiality;
- act with prudence in deciding whether and how to delegate authority;
- incur only costs that are reasonable in amount and appropriate to the investment responsibilities imposed by law;
- submit specific reports to the Legislative Assembly and to the Governor;
- approve all mutual funds in which Deferred Compensation Fund moneys are invested;
- approve any plan proposed by the investment officer in response to a default in the payment of interest or other income of any investment; and
- audit the investment funds investment program.
