BOARD ON PUBLIC SAFETY STANDARDS AND TRAINING

Composition³

The board consists of 26 members, including

- two chiefs of police recommended by the Oregon Association Chiefs of Police (DANIEL, SHEARER);
- one sheriff recommended by the Oregon State Sheriffs' Association (ROWAN);
- one fire chief recommended by the Oregon Fire Chiefs Association (HEPPEL);
- one fire service representative recommended by the Oregon Fire District Directors Association (MORNEAU);
- one member of the Oregon State Fire Fighters Council recommended by the council (ADAMS);
- one corrections personnel representative recommended by the Oregon State Sheriffs' Association (ENGLISH);
- one fire service representative recommended by the Oregon Volunteer Firefighters Association (CARRIGER);
- one public safety telecommunicators representative (FLETCHER);

- one district attorney recommended by the Oregon District Attorneys Association (VACANT);
- the Superintendent of State Police (CODDLING);
- the Chief of the Portland Police Bureau (DAY);
- the State Fire Marshal (RUIZ-TEMPLE);
- the Chief of the Portland Fire Bureau (GILLESPIE);
- the Director of the Department of Corrections (REESE);
- the Special Agent in Charge of the Federal Bureau of Investigation for Oregon, nonvoting (OLSON);
- one municipal administrator recommended by the League of Oregon Cities (BENNETT);
- two non-management law enforcement representatives (BARRETT, NOWNING);
- three public members (CABELLERO RUBIO, JONES, YOUNG);
- two private security industry representatives recommended by the industry (HASENKAMP, LENZEN);
- one representative of the collective bargaining unit representing the largest number of individual workers in the Department of Corrections (VACANT); and
- one non-management parole and probation officer employed by a community corrections program (**CAMERON**).

Members serve three-year terms and may be removed for cause. The board selects its chair and vice chair and must meet at least once every three months.

Duties⁴

The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training certifies and licenses police officers, corrections officers, parole and probation officers, regulatory specialists, telecommunicators, emergency medical dispatchers, criminal justice instructors, private security providers, private investigators, and polygraph examiners. The board provides governance to the department and establishes training and certification standards.

The board must

- promote the safety, efficiency, effectiveness, self-sufficiency, and competence of public safety agencies and professionals, and support collaboration;
- establish policy committees;
- recommend candidates for the department director;
- annually evaluate the director's implementation of policies, standards, and minimum requirements for public safety certifications and training;

- adopt rules for standards, certification, and training;
- approve any legislative concept, Emergency Board request, or agency budget requests before submission;
- consult with the department on specified reports, rules, and programs;
- ensure that police officers and certified reserve officers receive specified training;
- establish standards and procedures for psychological screening;
- establish procedures for denying, suspending, or revoking an application; and
- review discretionary actions.
