HB 2193

Requires State Department of Agriculture to study potential uses for animal processing waste products.

HB 2194 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to State Department of Agriculture, out of General Fund, for purpose of developing grant program to fund construction of meat rendering plants.

Public Hearing

HB 3163

Establishes Place-Based Water Planning Fund.

HB 3222

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to High Desert Partnership for specified purposes.

HB 3164

Makes permanent provisions conditionally allowing water right lease to split use of water between existing water right and in-stream water right within same year.

CARRIED OVER FROM THE 2-21-2023 MEETING: Modifies definition of "public agency" for purposes of eligibility for financial assistance from Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund by removing requirement that agency be authorized to construct water pollution control facilities.
