Work Session

HB 2687

Authorizes State Department of Agriculture to issue public applicator licenses and public trainee certificates to employees of federally recognized Indian tribes for purposes of pesticide application on certain lands adjacent to tribal lands.

HB 3097

Provides that municipal corporation or people's utility district may apply for certificate to use water for hydroelectric purposes within artificial delivery system even if municipal corporation or people's utility district is not holder of underlying water right, with permission of holder of underlying water right.

HB 3164

Makes permanent provisions conditionally allowing water right lease to split use of water between existing water right and in-stream water right within same year.

HB 3195

Modifies definition of "public agency" for purposes of eligibility for financial assistance from Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund by removing requirement that agency be authorized to construct water pollution control facilities.

HB 3211

Authorizes holder of water right certificate that authorizes storage of water for municipal use to change authorized point of diversion and place of use without losing priority of right under specified circumstances.

HB 3222

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for distribution to High Desert Partnership for specified purposes.

HB 3163

Establishes Place-Based Water Planning Fund.

HB 3231

Directs Department of Environmental Quality, in consultation with Water Resources Department, to develop recommendations and other resources to expand beneficial water reuse or recycled water programs or projects in state.

HB 3247 **

**Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys to Higher Education Coordinating Commission, for allocation to Oregon State University through Oregon Veterinary Diagnostic Laboratory, for specified purposes related to zoonotic disease.

HB 3207

Amends reporting requirements for real estate transaction sampling of domestic wells to require labs conducting tests to submit results to Department of Environmental Quality.

HB 3208

Authorizes Environmental Quality Commission to annually adjust, by up to three percent, fees associated with water quality programs administered by Department of Environmental Quality.

HB 3346

Establishes Task Force on the Water Rights and Transfers Protest Backlog.
