HB 2799 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Transportation for grants to erect and maintain livestock safety fencing along portions of state highway where there is high risk of conflict between traveling public and livestock.

HB 2685 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Restores availability of income or corporate excise tax credit for processing or collection of woody biomass.

### **Public Hearing**

HB 2631 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Provides that compensation for loss or injury to livestock or working dogs under wolf depredation compensation and financial assistance grant program must be based on multiplier of not more than seven times fair market value of livestock or working dogs and recommendation of county advisory committee.

HB 2633

Allows person who submits application for compensation under wolf depredation compensation and financial assistance grant program to amend application.

HB 2127

Requires Department of Land Conservation and Development to study changes to Land Conservation and Development Commission and abolishment of Land Use Board of Appeals.

HB 3440

Allows counties with population between 200,000 and 650,000 to elect to distribute receipts from sales of certain lands and mineral rights through alternative mechanism.

### HB 3458

Limits issues that may be basis for appeal of land use decisions where local government amends comprehensive plan or land use regulations.

### HB 2765

Grants to South Suburban Sanitary District exclusive right to use and sell treated wastewater discharged by district into Klamath River or tributaries.
