HB 2799 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Department of Transportation for grants to erect and maintain livestock safety fencing along portions of state highway where there is high risk of conflict between traveling public and livestock.

HB 3099

Requires Water Resources Department to study water management in Chewaucan River watershed.

HB 3232

Prohibits limitation on percentage of chinook and coho salmon that may be taken by commercial fisheries using alternative gears.

HB 2835 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Ways and Means

Directs State Department of Fish and Wildlife to establish pilot program to award grants for recreational fishing facilities within urban growth boundary.

HB 2685 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Restores availability of income or corporate excise tax credit for processing or collection of woody biomass.

HB 3244

Establishes Task Force on the Economic Competitiveness of Oregon Agriculture.

HB 2971 \*\*

\*\*Subsequent Referral(s) to Revenue

Includes as permissible farm use for purposes of property tax special assessment operation or use of farmland subject to farm-related government program for voluntary in-stream leasing of water rights.

#### **Public Hearing**

HB 3179

Requires State Department of Energy to study permitting requirements for renewable energy facilities and to develop recommendations to improve permitting process.

## AGENDA (cont.) March 28, 2023

HB 3180

Requires Department of Land Conservation and Development to study land use siting of solar photovolatic power generating facilities.

HB 3181

Directs State Department of Energy and Department of Land Conservation and Development to convene work group to examine barriers, opportunities and other issues related to renewable energy and transmission project siting in Oregon.

HB 3086

Clarifies process of Senate confirmation of members of State Fish and Wildlife Commission.
